

SCMFA Meeting Highlights November 2009

- Helmets will need to be cleaned during the winter months, volunteers will be needed
- Equipment deposit cheques and tax receipts will be handed out to families at the awards night
- Motion was made to amend the Earl Keeley Memorial Lifetime Scroll of Merit award to state that the person must have contributed not less than 7 years of volunteerism to the association instead of 10 years
- The CDMFA audit meeting notes were reviewed; 2009 monies still need to come in and need to be reviewed, accounting has been sloppy during the 2009 season and due diligence will be enforced in the 2010 season
- We will not know if we will get our subsidy for the new jerseys ordered this year until the 2009 accounting books have been reviewed and the budget is finalized
- CDMFA – Discussion was had regarding some of the changes proposed by Alberta Football such as adjustments to provincial playoffs and the football season starting in August – we need to get input from the coaches so that our opinions and suggestions may be given at the next meeting regarding these changes
